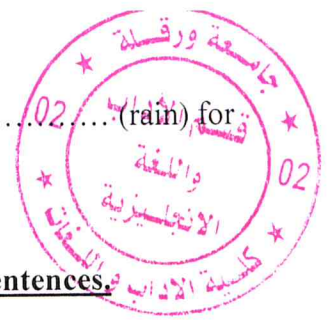
Exercise 2 (6pts)
