- 4-I wish someone **would** answer that telephone (A complaint about a present situation)
- 5-The meeting **shall** be delayed. (Insistence)
- 6-She **daren't** shout at her teacher. (Lack of bravery)
- 7-This boy looks like the teacher; he **will** be his son. (Supposition/ Deduction)
- 8- He does not answer. He **must** be out (Strong probability)
